We'll gather in the narthex for both the 8:00 & 10:00 services to receive our palms. The choir will give the passion message in song.

Maundy Thursday, April 1, 11 AM & 7 PM.
Holy Communion at both services, but at the evening service it will take place in the "Upper Room" around the cross.

Good Friday, April 2, 7:00 PM
In this "Tenebrae" (gradual darkening) service, the Seven Last Sayings of Jesus from the Cross will be reflected as the cross is raised.

Easter Sunday, April 4, 8:00 and 10:00 AM - Christ is risen, Alleluia!
